Study the Word of God using the HEART Method

- H Hear the Word
- E Explain the Context
- A Ask the Holy Spirit to Teach
- R Reveal God's Character and Will
- T Testify

Discipleship Begins with a Small Group of Friends

- 1. Gather with two or three friends to study a passage or book of the Bible.
- 2. Open with prayer thanking Jesus for being with you and asking the Holy Spirit to teach you.
- 3. Read aloud the portion of scripture being studied separating it into smaller parts.
- 4. Use Bible study helps to explain the historical and cultural context of the book and passages.
- 5. Explore related verses and Greek and Hebrew word meanings as you discuss each section.
- 6. Focus on God. What does the passage reveal about God and His will for our lives?
- 7. Testify together of His goodness, encouraging one another to walk in faith, obedience, and love.
- 8. Close in prayer, asking God for strength and wisdom to live out what has been learned.
- 9. Meet together regularly.
- 10. Encourage each person to meet with a second group of friends to multiply discipleship.
